# FB107 TRUCK UNLOADING ADDITION

#### Preparation

The following must be complete prior to startup:

- All devices securely installed and piping in place as per standard industry practices
- Power, signal and transmitter to sensor wiring connected
- Devices and panel should be powered or ready to be powered
- All operational data required including well locations with oil and water densities, trucking companies and any communication or I/O settings (if possible, the location and trucking company lists should be provided in excel format)
- A truck must be available loaded with sales spec oil to calibrate the Micro Motion, Ametek Drexelbrook and to test the operation of the skid
- For in-depth performance verification, a method of meter proving must be provided (this process may incur additional cost depending on the method used)

## Training

On-the-job training will consist of explanations while the customer witnesses the startup. If time permits, the specialist can provide a basic overview on meter fundamentals.
